No such vehicle shall be parked for any period of time, stored or otherwise permitted to remain on the property except in a unit's garage. All non-operable or non-functioning vehicles shall be subject to these restrictions and shall be at all times obscured from street view. All parking within property shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations adopted by the declarant or association.
- 2. This resolution and the amendment referenced above shall both remain in full force and effect until modified, rescinded, or superseded by a subsequent resolution of the Board.
